

**Step 1:** Navigate to [www.accessnyt.com](http://www.accessnyt.com).

**Step 2:** Search for and select "University of Connecticut – Storrs CT."

*You will be redirected to the NYT registration page.*

**Step 3:** Click "Create Account" and complete all required fields; you must use your [@uconn.edu](mailto:@uconn.edu) email.

**Step 4:** Verify your account (you will receive a confirmation email).\*

*\*The confirmation email may be routed to your spam folder. You must click the link in this email to complete the registration.*



## EXISTING NEW YORK TIMES ID:

If you have previously registered your [@uconn.edu](mailto:@uconn.edu) email address on The New York Times site, you will click the "Already have an account? Log in here" link for Step 3.

Your existing NYTimes ID will have to be free of any paid subscriptions in order to use the academic pass. In order to apply the academic pass to your University account, you will need to cancel any subscriptions first (or have customer care transfer them to different NYTimes accounts under a personal email).

Please either cancel the subscription in the "My Account" section that can be found in the upper right hand corner of NYTimes.com, or through the New York Times Customer Care Team ([customercare@nytimes.com](mailto:customercare@nytimes.com) / 800-591-9233). Once the account is inactive, you can visit [accessnytimes.com](https://accessnytimes.com) and follow the onscreen instructions for the academic pass.
